If so, you may be interested in a new study that we are conducting.

Your child may be eligible to participate in a long-term study called SPRITES, to learn about how sertraline or psychotherapy affect aspects of their cognitive, emotional, and physical development. By participating in a research study, you help researchers understand how drugs work in treating conditions that affect patients, their families, and communities. Under the care of their study doctor, your child will also receive additional monitoring by participating in research.

To qualify, your child must be :

- Between the ages of 6 & 16 years of age
- Receiving medication and/or psychotherapy in an outpatient setting
